Established in 1967 by a group of dedicated people and encouraged by the Nebraska Districts of LCMS, the camp purchased 160 acres and began the task of building roads, a lake and buildings. Today the camp is owned by an association of congregations from all over Nebraska. It is a registered 501©3 non-profit organization. In 2007 the camp will celebrate its 40th birthday.

Programs:

Today over 4000 children, youth and adults enjoy summer camps, retreats, outdoor education, family reunions, work weekends, service projects, day camps, family camps and much more at the camp’s year round programs and facilities.
