

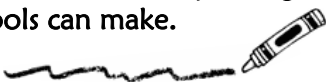
# Lutheran Schools in Nebraska are Making a Difference

As we were sitting there discussing the weather for the day, this new student burst out with, "**Who is that guy up there?**" and "**Why is he up there?**" Of course, that opened the door for a wonderful discussion, with **input from the other children** in the class, about the **work of salvation that Jesus** did for us all.



"**Who is this Jesus guy anyway?** You all seem like you know Him. What is this all about?" Josh, a sixth grader asked his second day in a Lutheran school. The next day, Josh asked to read a Bible passage. After he read it he proudly proclaimed, "**Today is the first day I read out of the Bible...ever!**"

After class, a classmate asked the teacher if it was true that Josh didn't know Jesus. The teacher acknowledged that Josh really didn't know Jesus. The classmate said, "**Oh, good! He lives six blocks from my house and I'm going to get to tell him about Jesus.**"
