Personalized Giving Mission Opportunities

Mission support dollars designated for any of the following personalized giving mission opportunities will be used for worker, property and/or program funding needs of the designated ministry as funded by the District unless a more specific designation is placed upon the support. All designated support dollars must be used in the manner designated, redirected in accordance with District policy when the ministry no longer exists as a District ministry, or the dollars must not be accepted or must be returned to the donor. Therefore, **it is extremely important that all designations must be as clear and complete as possible.**

Campus Ministry - Support dollars may be designated for campus ministry in general, or could be more specifically restricted to any Nebraska District campus ministry.

District Mission and Ministry Grants - Includes the ministry funding and other new mission opportunity grants as they are requested and become available.

Ethnic Ministry – Support dollars may be designated for Ethnic Ministry in general, or could be more specifically restricted to the ethnic ministry of your choice at the District. The support dollar designation could specify an ethnic population such as African, African American, African Immigrant, Hispanic, Native American, Asian, Sudanese, etc. In addition, specific opportunities include current ethnic ministries such as the Hispanic Ministry at Cristo Cordero de Dios in Grand Island, the Hispanic Ministry at Jesús Es El Señor in Omaha, the Native American Ministry at Jesus Our Savior Lutheran Outreach in Winnebago, the Sudanese Ministry at Sudanese Evangelical Lutheran Church in mission in Omaha, the partnership for support of Sudan in Africa and the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Sudan, or another specific ethnic ministry or a new ethnic ministry could be suggested.
