Immigrant & Refugee Ministry

Ministry partnerships in Omaha provide for human care needs and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with these and other immigrant and refugee groups: African, especially Ethiopian and Sudanese; Middle Eastern; Asian; and Muslim. To learn more, visit ndlcms.org/we-engage.

Peace International Friendship Center, Omaha (project #19-001)

The Peace Center is a caring place where immigrants and refugees from any country can learn English, prepare for U.S. citizenship, gain useful skills and make lasting friendships. Along with classes, the Center offers a number of cultural experiences, such as meals, programs, and festivals at Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and for other holidays. Immigrants and refugees are cared for through health fairs and by providing for human care needs. The Center is also a place for immigrants to gather socially and for relationships to be built.

Sudanese Evangelical Lutheran Church in Mission, Omaha

(project #278-000)

This LCMS congregation gathers for weekly worship at the Peace Center, as well as providing a Bible study and fellowship group for young adults. Members and leaders are also involved in the caring ministry of the Center.

Ethiopian Ministry (project #18-402)

A group of Ethiopian immigrants meets at the Peace Center weekly for Bible study and worship with Rev. Eddie Mekasha. These immigrants also help connect new immigrants to the services and care of the Center.

Hispanic Ministry (project #272-200)

The number of Hispanic immigrants in Omaha is growing, and more and more of these neighbors are getting connected to the Peace Center. The Lord provided Carlos Mestayer to serve and minister at the Peace Center. What a blessing it is having a worker who can speak Spanish and build relationships with this community to be able to share the saving message of Jesus Christ and plant the seeds of faith.
